International Seminar of Investment Casting

The 8th ISIC will be held in Kaohsiung, Taiwan on the 8 – 10 November 2014.

The Taiwan Foundry Society (TFS) will host this international conference which is the major investment casting conference in Asia and it will be the first time the ISIC will take place in Taiwan.

Since its inception in 1999 the ISIC seminar has taken place bi-annually and has served as the premier conference for Asia's developing investment casting industry which now accounts for 35% of global investment casting sales.

Importantly the ISIC provides Asian foundries with a platform for discussion and exchange of information with resultant benefits

to communication and cooperation for companies and academics.

More than 150 participants from all parts of the world, including Europe, USA, China, Taiwan, and South Korea, are expected to attend the event.

Blayson will be exhibiting and Ron Williams will present market reviews covering North America and Europe. Additionally Dave Bond will present a paper on the 'Characteristics and Control of Investment Casting Wax'.
